Projects: Must generally be for charitable, educational, community betterment, or purposes that benefit residents in Grady EMC's service area. Funds will not be awarded for political activities, debt repayment, or purposes unrelated to the approved application.

Funding Philosophy: Operation Round Up strives to assist as many worthwhile projects as possible each cycle. Requests are typically a portion of the total project cost, and awards generally range from \$500 to \$5,000. Larger requests may be considered if they have a significant, broad community impact.

Note: Operation Round Up funds are not used to pay an individual's utility bill.
